Campaign Travellers Update



Consultation is under way for the proposed Gypsy & Traveller site next to Derwent School now - the closing date is 7th June.

There is a link to CBC's site where you can lodge your objections, and also a choice of 10 different example letters that you can send in - feel free to edit them or personalise them if you like (look for the "Objection Letters" tab). You can send in as many letters as you like if they refer to different objections. Bear in mind, though, that for your objections to count, they must *only* refer to relevant planning issues and CBC will reject any deemed to be racist or discriminatory.

As of 13th May, 110 letters had been sent in; the more objections they get, the more likely CBC are to take note of them.
