Parish Council News



The recent resignation of the Clerk to the Council has been followed by resignations of the Chair and Vice Chair. At an Extraordinary Meeting this week, James Stirling was elected Chair, and Kevin Smith Vice Chair. The position of Clerk is still vacant.

Stondon Parish Council has recently provided feedback to Central Bedfordshire Council Highways Department in response to consultation documents issued by CBC.

SPC has identified a number of sustainable highways improvement schemes for the village. These include traffic calming and safety measures to Hillside Road, Station Road, Bedford Road [A600], Shillington Road and the Upper Stondon Church area.

Feedback provided by SPC to the annual survey, confirmed SPC's opinions on the condition of the highways in our Parish and where extra effort should be provided.

SPC hope that by responding to both documents CBC's Highways Department will improve their service delivery as well as most importantly improve the conditions of the highways and roads in the village; both matters being considered of vital importance to parishioners of Stondon.
